Cookie Policy

aPay Systems Ltd, a Company registered under the laws of Malta, having Company Registration Number C 87249, registered at Phoenix Business Centre, The Penthouse, Old Railway Track, Santa Venera SVR 9022, (hereinafter referred to as 'aPay' and/or 'Company' and/or 'We' and/or 'Us') is the Data Controller for the purposes of applicable data protection law.

aPay uses cookies on the <https://apay.pro/> website (hereinafter referred to as the 'Website'), and the server location is in Hong Kong.

This Policy explains what cookies are, why and how we use cookies, how third parties may use cookies on our Website, your choices in relation to cookies and any other information about cookies.

1. COOKIES - WHAT ARE THEY

Cookies are small text files (mainly numbers and letters) placed or downloaded on your device when you visit or access a website. On each subsequent visit cookies are sent back to the originating website.

Cookies are useful since they allow a website to recognise a user's device and to store information about your preferences or past actions.

Certain cookies are required for the sole purpose of carrying out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communications network - others may be required for the provision of service over the internet.

Cookies may also be desirable to improve the user's experience; in which case we will ask for your consent to use such cookies.

2. HOW WE USE COOKIES

aPay uses cookies for a variety of purposes, mainly:

- to improve the user's experience;
- to distinguish between visitors and their location;
- to improve the use and functionality of the website;
- to enable certain functions of the website (e.g. navigation, access to secure areas, aggregate statistics about the number of visitors)
- to obtain data about how the website is being used.



Furthermore, the collection of such data enables us to develop, optimise and facilitate the use of our Website.

Cookies may either be deleted automatically when the user closes the website browser (also known as ‘**session cookies**’) or are stored on the user’s device to facilitate future visits (also known as ‘**permanent cookies**’). The latter cookies will also be deleted automatically after a specified period of time.

Some cookies are needed to run the website. For example, when you log in, cookies help to recognise you and keep you logged in as you browse the website. We call these ‘**strictly necessary cookies**’.

3. WHAT COOKIES WE USE

The Domain uses 12 cookies in total.

The following table lists:

- the type of cookies placed on the website;
- their function;
- the purpose(s) for which the data is collected and for how long it is retained.

Please note that the name of the cookies may change over time.

Preference Cookies: Preference cookies enable the website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Please note that if you do so, you might not be able to make use of the full functionality and the features of the website, you may not be able to store your preferences and some of our pages might not display properly.

All cookies on your computer can be deleted and you can set most browsers to prevent cookies from being placed. If you do this, you may manually have to adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.

6. INFORMATION COLLECTED

Information from your device	Whenever you use our website or the app, we collect the following information:
	Technical information, including the internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the internet, your log-in information, the browser type and version, the time-zone setting, the operating system and platform, the type of device you use, a unique device identifier (for example, your device's IMEI number, the MAC address of the device's wireless network interface, or the mobile phone number used by the device), mobile network information, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile browser you use and so on.
	Information about your visit, including the links you have clicked on, through and from our site (including date and time), services you viewed or searched for, page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling and clicks), and methods used to browse away from the page.
	Information on transactions (for example, payments into and out of your account), including the date, time, amount, currencies, exchange rate, beneficiary details, details of the merchant or ATMs associated with the transaction, IP address of sender and receiver, sender's and receiver's name and registration information, messages sent or received with the payment, details of device used to arrange the payment and the payment method used.



	Information stored on your device, including if you give us access to contact information from your address book, log-in information, photos, videos or other digital content, check-ins (sometimes, we call this content information). The app will regularly collect this information in order to stay up to date.
Information about your location	If you have location services in the app switched on, we track your location using GPS technology and your IP address.
Information from others	We collect information from third parties, such as credit-reference agencies, fraud-prevention agencies and partners who help us to provide our services.
	This includes your credit record, information to help us check your identity, and information relating to your transactions.
